The event will include vendors, food trucks and members of the Blue Ridge Health System.

Pink Night is also on the same day and starts at 8pm and is our Womanless Beauty Contest where all you men get to dress up as women and raise funds for our cause.

Pink Day is fundraising event to raise funds for those who cannot afford or have no health insurance to obtain lifesaving screenings such as mammogram and prostate exams for detections of cancers.
